Skill: Students will be able to classify objects into a given category, count the number of objects in each category and sort the categories by count.

Set out dish pans with water, add fishing bobbers in different sizes. Let the children scoop out the bobbers with small fish nets. Children can also sort the bobbers by size into small, medium, and large containers. Have the children count and graph how many bobbers they scooped out of each size.









Campfire Rhymes

Set: Children will demonstrate an understanding of spoken words and sounds, recognize and generate simple words, and use simple words to form sentences.

Place each child at a table, place the marshmallows on the table face up. Go around the table and give each word that would rhyme with a marshmallow. Example: "What rhymes with bear?" Child then finds marshmallow with bee. Repeat for the right marshmallow. Then you can place it on the stick by using magnets.

Rhymes with: bear, tent, cat, black, peep, fly, fur, now, box, hat, tin, hovel, bear and bird.

Laminate pieces to the game. Cut out and place magnets (stickers or the backs of marshmallows) and place magnetic stickers on the letters.
