






Pick one of the cover for your binder.


Print onto cardstock.





















Make tabs

Copy taps onto cardstock and cut out.

Place a sheet of cardstock in a sleeve protector. Tape the tab to the sleeve protector.

I place my tabs on the sleeve protectors because I place all of my masters in sleeve protectors. If You tape your taps on the card stock you will not be able to see the taps when your looking through the binder.





Weekly Dividers

Separate each month with weekly dividers. This way I send out each months worth of activities evenly throughout the month.
