Say It, Count It, Write It

Roll and Count Mats

Give each child a roll and count mat and a number dice or dotted dice. Have the children roll a dice and identify the number on the dice (say it). Once they have identified the number have them count out the objects (count it). After the children have counted out the right amount of objects have them write the number on the mat with a dry erase marker (write it).



Roll and Add Mats

Give each child a roll and add mat, two dice, and counters. Have the children roll a dice and identify the number on the dice (say it). Once they have identified the number have them count out the counters (count it). Repeat for second dice. Once they have counted out all the counters have them add the two together and write the amount on the mat. (Write it)



Roll and Subtract Mats

Give each child a roll and subtract mat, worksheet, one dice, and counters. Have the children write the number in the first square that is on their worksheet and count out that amount of counters. (Count it) Next have child roll dice, identify number and take that amount off the mat. (Write it)
